- On Friday September 25th at 7pm, LRCC joins the Australian Girls' Chorus with a special guest at Emmanuel Church in Thousand Oaks.
- On Sunday November 8th at 2pm, LRCC's Amadeus choir joins Areté in Concert at the Cal Lutheran University (CLU) Samuelson Chapel in Thousand Oaks for a performance of "An American in Paris" feature works by Gershwin, Fauré, Debussy, and Ravel.
- On Saturday December 19th at 3pm and 7pm, all four LRCC choirs will perform their annual Holiday Wonder concert of holiday favorites at CLU's Samuelson Chapel.
- On Sunday March 20th at 4pm, LRCC joins Los Robles Master Chorale and the Agoura High School Choir in "Zimbe!", a musical extravaganza of pan-African folk songs and languages, at the Agoura Performing Arts Center in Agoura Hills.
- On Sunday, May 15th at 4pm, all four LRCC choirs will perform "Britain or Bust!", a performance of works by British composers launching the choir on its summer Canterbury tour. The performance will be at Ascension Lutheran Church in Thousand Oaks.
