Los Robles Children's Choir Announces New Leadership

Thousand Oaks, California – October 8, 2012 – [Los Robles Children's Choir](#) (LRCC) today announced Dana Rouse as the organization's new Executive Director and Edward Rouse as the new Artistic Director. Dana will lead the area's premier youth choir, now in its sixteenth year, after the retirement of founding Artistic Director Donna Young earlier this year.

Dana Rouse, a graduate of The Eastman School with a Master's Degree in Vocal Performance and Pedagogy, is also a private voice teacher who has a special interest in children's music. In addition to her role as Executive Director, Dana will conduct LRCC's Apprentice and Bel Canto choirs.

Edward Rouse, also a graduate of The Eastman School of Music with a Master's Degree in Choral Conducting, is the head of vocal and choral music at Oaks Christian School in Westlake Village. Edward will conduct LRCC's Amadeus, Amadeus Chamber Singers and Camerata Chamber Choirs. Both Dana and Edward have previously sung with the [Los Robles Master Chorale](#) with which the LRCC jointly performs.

"Edward and I share a common vision for developing artistry in every child and are excited about working with the 120+ singers this season", said Dana. "We look forward to growing this vital community organization while providing a fun, learning environment for our singers to cultivate their musical talents."
